## FROM THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

### Happy Christmas

I would like to take the opportunity to wish all member of the Caroline Chisholm College community a safe, relaxing and Christ-filled Christmas. Thank you for all your support this year and for the trust you put in us to look after your daughters. I look forward to continue to work with the whole community, students, parents, teachers and ancillary staff, to make Caroline Chisholm College a place where all students can learn in a safe and supportive environment.

### Uniforms

As mentioned in the last email, I would like parents to check over the holidays to make sure your daughter's uniform meets requirements. It is a strong expectation of the parent body of Caroline Chisholm College that uniform standards are maintained.

In particular, every girl must start the year with her skirt worn to the bottom of the knee. If this is not the case, please arrange for the hem to be taken down or a new skirt bought. Please check also that the skirts fit properly around the waist. Some girls have skirts which are too loose and their solution is to roll it at the top, making it a little tighter around the waist. The problem then is that a skirt which appears to be the right length when purchased becomes too short.

As you would know from previous newsletters, the uniform shop procedures have changed. The college uniform shop is open Mondays from 8.00 am to 10.45am and Thursdays from 12.15 pm to 3.00 pm. If that time is not convenient, there are some alternatives for parents. Uniforms items can be ordered online. Go to the college website and you will find a link to the Uniform Shop under the Enrolment pull-down menu. Follow the links to place your order. For a small price, the item can be delivered to a home address. You can also go to [theschoollocker.com.au](http://theschoollocker.com.au) and search for Caroline Chisholm. Alternatively, if the item is in stock at the school, it will be given to the student on the next day the uniform shop is open. It may take slightly longer if the item is not in stock. Stock availability is normally indicated when the order is placed. Old skirts in good condition can be bought and sold directly between parents through the site linked to the uniform shop on the college website.

**The uniform shop is also open during the week before school starts back from 8.00 am to 3.00 pm on Monday 22, Tuesday 23, Wednesday 24, Friday 25 and Monday 29 January.**

Shoes must be black, polishable, leather and lace-up. The college shoe expectation is that shoes

- must be black, lace-up, polishable and cover the top of the foot.
- must have heels or moulded soles (no flats) but of a reasonable height (no more than 3 cms)
- must be lace-up, not slip-on
- cannot be gym-style Converse or the like, even if they are black leather.

These expectations are for both uniform and WHS requirement. Please do not buy an expensive but incorrect pair of shoes as you will be required to purchase a new pair. If a store does not have the correct type, try a different store. Local shoe stores have been advised about Caroline Chisholm College shoe requirements. I would also advise not leaving it to the week before school starts as they are often in short supply by that time.

Please note the following styles which are not acceptable:



We are absolutely committed to maintaining the uniform standard. Given the warnings that have been made, both generally and individually, throughout this term there is no reason for a girl not starting 2018 without the correct uniform.

Please assist us in starting the year with all girls in perfect uniform so we can present a strong and proud image of the college and allow staff to focus on the teaching of your daughters.



### Senior Satchels

In the last newsletter, I mentioned that senior students (Years 10-12) would no longer be allowed to use the college tote bags to take books and laptops to and from school. From the start of next year, they must continue to use their college backpack or, alternatively, buy one of the new college satchels which will be available from the start of the year. These can be bought from the college uniform shop (or ordered through [theschoollocker.com.au](http://theschoollocker.com.au)) when they become available shortly. The new senior college satchel will cost \$50.

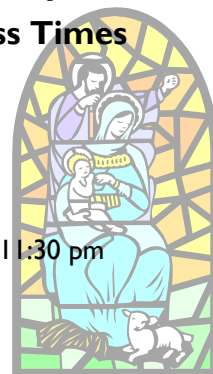
