FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents, Friends, Staff and Students of Caroline Chisholm College,

This is our final newsletter for 2016, and I feel amazed and blessed when I reflect on all that has taken place at the college this year. Many people ask me "Is the college winding down at this time of the year?". No - is the short answer. We are as busy and engaged as at any other time of the year. Just this week our Year 9 students went through their training program for Peer Support, ready to assist our new Year 7 with their transition to high school. Our presentation assemblies for each year group last week were wonderful opportunities to celebrate excellence in learning and in community service and participation.

Last Tuesday and Wednesday, we enjoyed our annual Arts Exhibition. Student work from Year 7 to 12 was on display for the enjoyment and wonderment of a very large crowd of parents and friends. I even noticed art teachers from other schools visiting to get a sense of why our college is so successful in this area. There are two clear reasons. Last Saturday I joined a large number of students and staff to support our local St Vincent de Paul Society deliver hampers to families in the Glenmore Park area. Our students were stunning examples of what it means to be a Chisholm girl. Dressed immaculately in their summer uniforms and with grace and compassion they visited families in their homes to distribute the more than 60 hampers contributed by our college. We pray for her and for the wellbeing of her brand-new family. We also bid farewell to **Miss Aurora Daines** who has been teaching music these past two terms. I am grateful for the many music events she has assisted with in her time here.

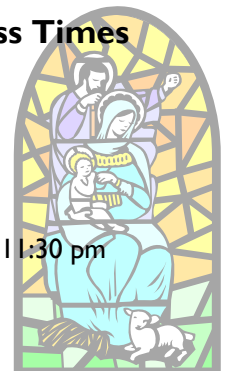

FROM THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

Happy Christmas

I would like to take the opportunity to wish all members of the Caroline Chisholm College community a safe, relaxing and Christ-filled Christmas. Thank you for all your support this year and for the trust you put in us to look after your daughters. I look forward to continue to work with the whole community, students, parents, teachers and ancillary staff, to make Caroline Chisholm College a place where all students can learn in a safe and supportive environment.

Uniforms

As mentioned in the last email, I would like parents to check over the holidays to make sure your daughter's uniform meets requirements. It is a strong expectation of the parent body of Caroline Chisholm College that uniform standards are maintained.

In particular, every girl must start the year with her skirt worn to the bottom of the knee. If this is not the case, please arrange for the hem to be taken down or a new skirt bought. Please check also that the skirts fit properly around the waist. Some girls have skirts which are too loose and their solution is to roll it at the top, making it a little tighter around the waist. The problem then is that a skirt which appears to be the right length when purchased becomes too short.

The normal uniform shop hours during the year are Tuesday 8.00 am to 11.30 am. If that time is not convenient, there are some alternatives for parents. Students can be measured for uniforms when the shop is open. Payment can then be made by phoning the uniform shop during its opening hours or phoning the reception at any time and quoting an invoice number from the uniform shop.

The uniform shop is also open during the week before school starts back from 9.00 am to 12.00 pm and 12.30 pm to 2.30 pm on Monday 23, Tuesday 24, Wednesday 25 and Friday 27 January. You might also like to check the availability of second-hand skirts. These (along with second-hand books) are sold privately through the college website. Follow the links to find details of available clothing and contact details for the sellers.

Shoes must be black, polishable, leather and lace-up. The college shoe expectation is that shoes

- must be black, lace-up, polishable and cover the top of the foot.
- must have heels or moulded soles (no flats) but of a reasonable height (no more than 3 cms)
- must be lace-up, not slip-on
- cannot be gym-style Converse or the like, even if they are black leather.

These expectations are for both uniform and WHS requirement. Please do not buy an expensive but incorrect pair of shoes as you will be required to purchase a new pair. If a store does not have the correct type, try a different store. Local shoe stores have been advised about Caroline Chisholm College shoe requirements. I would also advise not leaving it to the week before school starts as they are often in short supply by that time.

Please note the following styles which are not acceptable:



We are absolutely committed to maintaining the uniform standard. Given the warnings that have been made, both generally and individually, throughout this term there is no reason for a girl not starting 2017 without the correct uniform. Students who do not have the correct uniform at the start of next year may be asked to remain at home until this is remedied.

Please assist us in starting the year with all girls in perfect uniform so we can present a strong and proud image of the college and allow staff to focus on the teaching of your daughters.

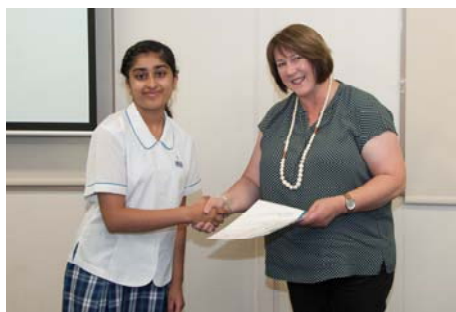

2016 VISUAL ARTS AND PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITION

Our annual Visual Arts and Photography exhibition was held last week and was opened by the contemporary artist, **Mehwish Iqbal**.
